- ☐ Required medication in original packaging



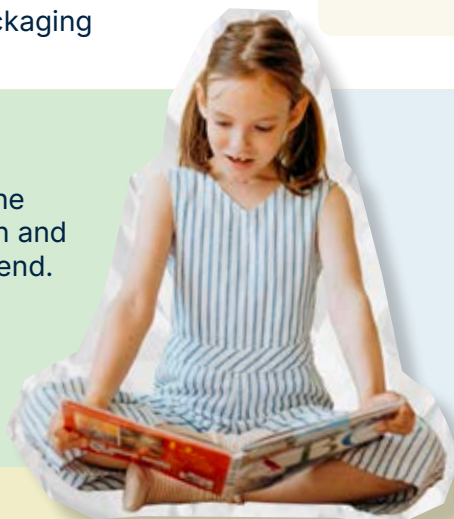
This is a legal requirement under the Education & Care National Regulations and in the interests of the safety of children, care may be refused or delayed if the required documentation and medication has not been supplied.

How to book

To secure your child's place, all bookings must be made through the **Xplor Home App**.

If your child does not currently attend Outside of Schools Hours Care (OSHC) at the school, please complete the enrolment form. Once the enrolment form is submitted, you can then book your child's place through the Xplor Home App. Please select the appropriate day and session within the app.

Child Care Subsidy

All sessions are approved for the Child Care Subsidy (CCS), allowing eligible families to reduce their out-of-pocket expenses. To check your eligibility for CCS, visit the [Services Australia website](https://servicesaustralia.gov.au) or login to your MyGov account.

Cancellation Policy

We require a minimum of 7 days' notice for any session cancellations.

Failure to provide sufficient notice will result in the full session fee being charged. In these instances, the session will be marked as an absence.

For families eligible for the Child Care Subsidy (CCS), please note that CCS will still be applied to the absence, but the gap fee will be payable.
